

Rollama Spelling Scheme

Our spelling scheme includes 10 words per week, 36 weeks per Year, covering all the National Curriculum spelling objectives, and ordered by difficulty. Concepts (e.g. prefixes) are grouped into chunks of three or four weeks. These have been spread throughout the calendar to avoid monotony (e.g. the NC specifies 12 different prefix topics, which we have grouped into four chunks across Years 3 & 4).

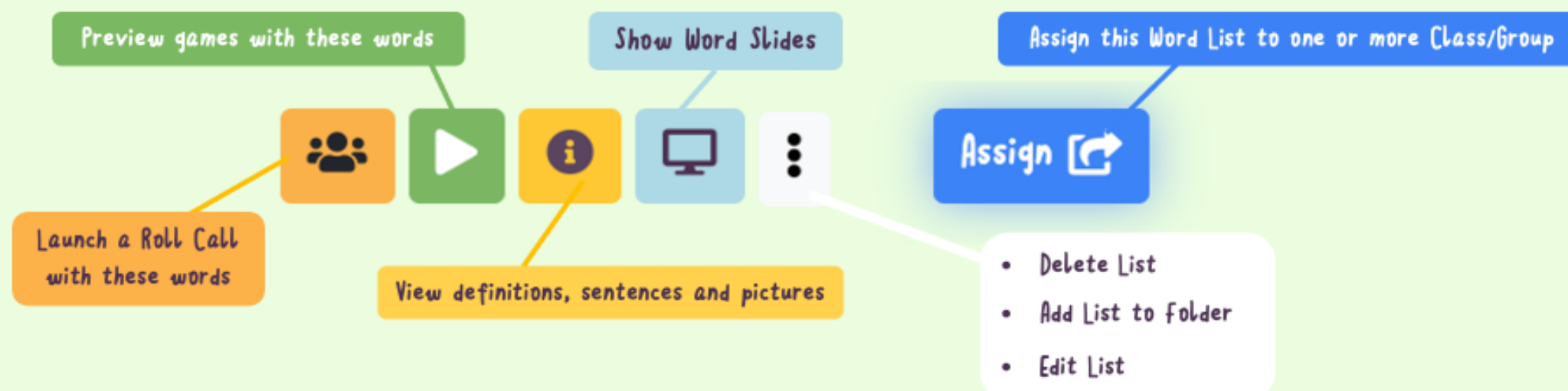
From Years 3 to 6, we have included a half-termly recap list, which includes 10 words from 10 different weeks in the previous Year.
